

AAC ASSESSMENT & IMPLEMENTATION CERTIFICATE COURSES BY AT10

This course, hosted by RC SELPA, prepares participants to assess students with complex communication needs who may benefit from augmentative and alternative communication (AAC). Through in-person and online sessions and guided coaching, participants will complete an AAC assessment using a class-provided template. Upon successful completion, they will earn a 45-hour certificate. Optional 3.0 Graduate Level PDUs are available for an additional fee. (Note: This course does not cover assistive technology.)

Attendance is required for **ALL SESSIONS** in the Series. You are not able to mix/match sessions. **If an attendee does not complete the course, their district will be responsible for the full cost.**
